Quifactum creates digital product passports (DPPs) that can be created in minutes. They offer brands end-to-end transparency on origin, materials, production, repair, return, recycling, certificates, and authenticity. Their DPPs support not only compliance with the new European Ecodesign Regulation, but also storytelling, customer loyalty, and efficient returns management.



Renewi

Renewi is a leading waste-to-product company that goes beyond traditional waste collection. Waste is given a second life by converting it into high-quality, circular raw materials. From plastics and wood to metals, minerals, glass and organic materials, Renewi's recycled materials are designed for reuse and repurposing.



Return2Sender

Return2Sender develops a reusable pallet wrap that offers a sustainable alternative to conventional wrapping film. Their fully circular packaging system is cleverly designed: in addition to the wrap itself, it includes a return logistics process, recovery service, and optional tracking capabilities.

Seenons is building a future without waste. Their digital platform connects companies with transporters, recyclers, and circular processors. Residual streams become raw materials again, with logistics as the link. Nothing goes to waste and everything will get a second life.



The Green Revolution
